Anna Maria Tammaro (<http://www.unipr.it/arpa/benicult/biblio/master/amten.htm>) from the Department of History of Civilization and Theatre will the international Master in ICT. The Master is established in collaboration between the University of Parma and University of Northumbria. The language of the Master is English. Students meet in Blackboard and twice in both of the cities. Anna Maria Tammaro will also present a EU project on digital libraries in E-learning. **Renata Livraghi and Barbara Rondelli** from the Department of Educational Science tells us about the 3 year long experience of the Master in management of social education.

19.00 **Visit to ITG CAMILLO RONDANI Parma**

Bruna Bassi from the technical college Rondani (www.itg-rondani.it) is online with her adult pupils in a course of basic Italian and History. We will attend the evening course as observers. Adult continuing education in Italy is - like in Denmark – under influence of the facts that students have been working all day before coming online, it's a long time ago since they went to school and they don't have high expectations to the output of the education. On the top of this economy is an obstacle. The work of Brunna Bassi is voluntary and based on rather simple technology as web cam and power points. In the end of each session the students are offered a number of links for their own individual exploration. This course is part of the ministerial experimentation "Sirius".

09.00 **Visit to Iris Versari in Cesena**

Gioachino Colombrita from "Iris Versari" (youth educational institute of social, health and child care), <http://lnx.irisversari.it/moodle/index.php?lang=en>, will demonstrate an experimental, virtual learning environment. With the use of 3D and co-operative learning the students of this school – as a part of their curricula - develop a

pedagogical course of cross-school co-operation for kids in the first years of elementary school <http://lnx.irisversari.it/xoops/modules/news/> . "Iris Versari" is making a great effort in e-learning. They use the platform Moodle and tools as Wiki and blogs (<http://www.scuola3d.eu/weblog/>).

11.00 **Visit to University of Bologna**

Valentina Comba, CELAB (E-learning development centre <http://www.unibo.it/Portale/Ateneo/Strutture/Strutture+di+servizio/82139/default.htm>), presents the methods and training programme for the E-tutors in further and higher education and specifically within linguistic sciences. "Our mission is to support the introduction of e-learning (blended learning) in the Academic structures (27 "Facoltà" as we call them in Italy) for any level of courses, facilitate the adoption of standards, provide technological assistance for e-learning platforms, and provide training at any level for everyone wishing to apply e-learning. We started with a small project for secondary schools pupils introduction to the university of Bologna courses offers ("Progetto orientamento"). We support three LCMS (platforms): www.elarning.unibo.it. We are running and maintaining the online courses for computer skills (A3). I personally foresee your visit, also to set up links and mutual exchanges, and maybe some partnership for the Lifelong Programme for the EC."

Alessia Gramigna from the regional HR department will present the platform on which the e-learning training of the public employed takes place <http://crc-self.odl.net>). The region has developed - together with private companies - a platform on which regional and provincial units can run the supplementary training. Two E-learning projects and the pedagogical approaches will be presented.

10.00 Visit to Imaginary

Lucia Pannese, CEO of the company Imaginary s.r.l. shows us some of their solutions: simulations and serious games based on own technologies developed in Java, mainly with web interface. The visit includes a brief company presentation, a brief market scenario and challenges for training and finally a discussion: what are serious games: definitions and characteristics and finally some case studies. On the web site www.i-maginary.it (also in English) some case studies are described and a few demos are shown with animations.

Manuela Pegoraro from METID - which is the e-learning development centre of the Polytechnical Institute - presents amongst other the use of Web 2 technologies in the courses in the institute. METID is quite advanced and experienced in e-learning (www.metid.polimi.it).

14.30 Visit to ITSOS, Technical College in Cernusco

Pierfranco Ravotto, engineer, tutor and expert of learning and E-learning, from "ITSOS Marie Curie di Cernusco sul Naviglio" presents his experiences with blended learning as well as an EU project (SLOOP) about the condivision of pedagogical materials for e-learning. SLOOP stands for Sharing Learning Object in an Open Perspective. The principal product will be freeLOms, free Learning Object management system. www.sloopproject.eu

ITSOS is a school that loves to experiment. Blended learning and E-learning has been a part of the teaching for most of the teachers for ten years now. FirstClass has been the main software but starting from this year ITSOS uses MOODLE, a virtual learning environment based on constructivist principles and on OpenSource.
